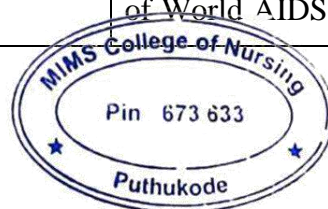



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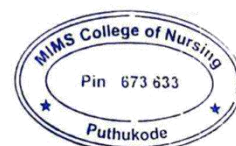

Role play in progress by NSS Volunteers



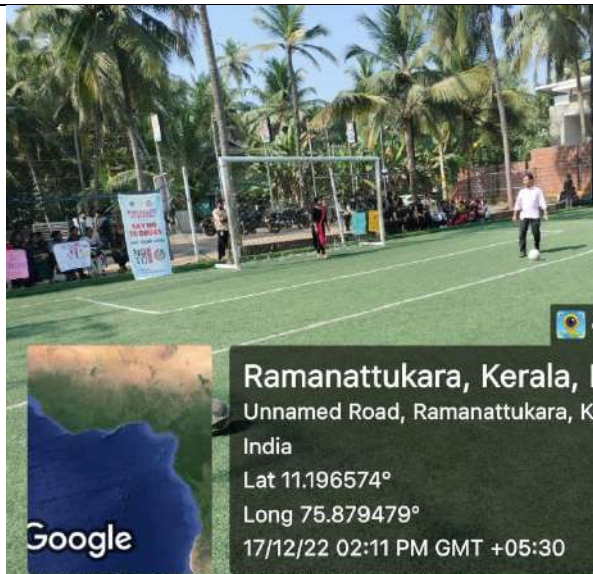
			Fig.2	Role play watch by Public, Dean, Faculty and Hospital staff

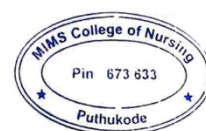





Fig. 3 Medical camp at GHS Munderi

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

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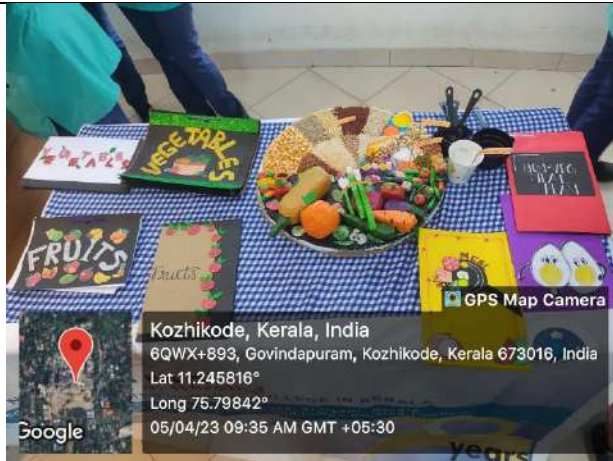


Fig. 1 Health Life style model prepared by NSS volunteers







Fig. 3 NSS volunteers measure anthropometric parameters to calculate bmi





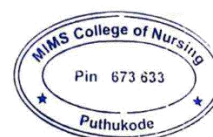
Fig.4 Public clarifies their doubts with NSS volunteers



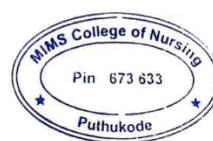







Fig. 3 Paanch Pran Oath, NSS PO

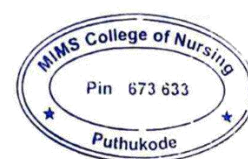




Fig. 4 & 5 NSS Volunteers in Amrit vadika

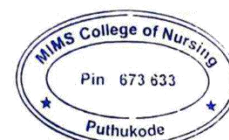




Fig. 3 NSS volunteers with other team members
